### THE BAR

WHAT YOU NEED: A compact, portable bar that lets guests help themselves. "It takes five minutes to set up," says creative director Tereasa Surratt, proprietor of Camp Wandawega in Elkhorn, Wis.

- 1. Bring together two decanters, a couple bottles of liquor, a bottle of soda, glasses, ice bucket and tongs, cocktail napkins. Add vintage touches: Cocktail stirrers, jiggers, and glassware, which you can keep or send home with guests as a party favor.
- 2. Arrange atop a vintage suitcase (which adds more height than a tray).
- 3. Post-party, pack your bar into the suitcase, which you can leave on display. If you're going to a friend's, pack the bar in the suitcase. and make it a hostess gift.

- PLACE IT: Set up your bar in a spot that's out of the main traffic flow. Finding it lets guests explore, and they'll have room to linger and chat while mixing a drink.
